2021/2022 HIGHLIGHTS

Over 17 parishioners contribute their musical talent to our liturgies, and 3 children sing in our kids' choir.

Over 160 parishioners serve in liturgical ministries as Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, and Greeters.

7 parishioners gather to pray the Rosary before daily Mass for the intentions of the parish and individuals.

There are 7 catechists who teach in our Religious Education programs, teaching students from preschool through high school.

We have 2 Baptism Formation Ministers who prepared our families for baptism of their children.

We have 6 Funeral\Bereavement Coordinators who help families prepare for all the details involved in funeral planning.

Our St. Vincent de Paul Council, made up of 33 active members and 19 associate members of St. Gabriel, served in taking care of a total of 385 people, which included 87 home visits for assistance. As a result, \$106,721 was given in shelter & utilities assistance and over \$6,200 in food, gas and gift cards were given to those in need.

VIBRANT VINNIES: Inspired by our St. Vincent de Paul Conference, our 25 Vibrant Vinnies are 5th through 8th graders, who are engaged in prayer, gospel reflections, education on St. Vincent de Paul Society, and issues of poverty. They put their faith in action through missionary activities such as serving food boxes, volunteering in the St. Vincent de Paul Hope Chest Thrift Story, and preparing food, clothing, shoe, and backpack drives for the homeless. These are just a few of the works of mercy they do as together they strive for holiness.

Thanksgiving Outreach: During our Thanksgiving Food Drive, over 1,100 lbs. of food were given to St. Edward's Parish for distribution, and over 2,800 lbs. of food to the Cave Creek Food Bank for Cave Creek families in need.


Christmas Giving Tree: 350 gifts were collected from St. Gabriel parishioners that assisted 16 St. Edwards families, and over 100 children.

his year, St. Gabriel the Archangel Catholic Church celebrates our 20-year anniversary! On Christmas Eve 2002, Fr. Jack Spaulding celebrated the first Mass under an open canopy-like structure with some parishioners sitting on bales of hay while others sat in chairs. Thus, the 300 or so founding parishioners (many of whom are still active) are affectionately called "Hay Balers." And I'd be remiss if I forgot Amy Jo Hutchison, a dedicated parishioner, who oversaw the entire construction and budget for a fraction of what she deserved.

Now that the buildings are built, we move into the next phase, which is building of the Church of St. Gabriel — that is you! St. Gabriel exists to bring every person into intimacy with Christ. The reason I am a priest, and your Pastor, is to help you and your families/community — get to Heaven. 


