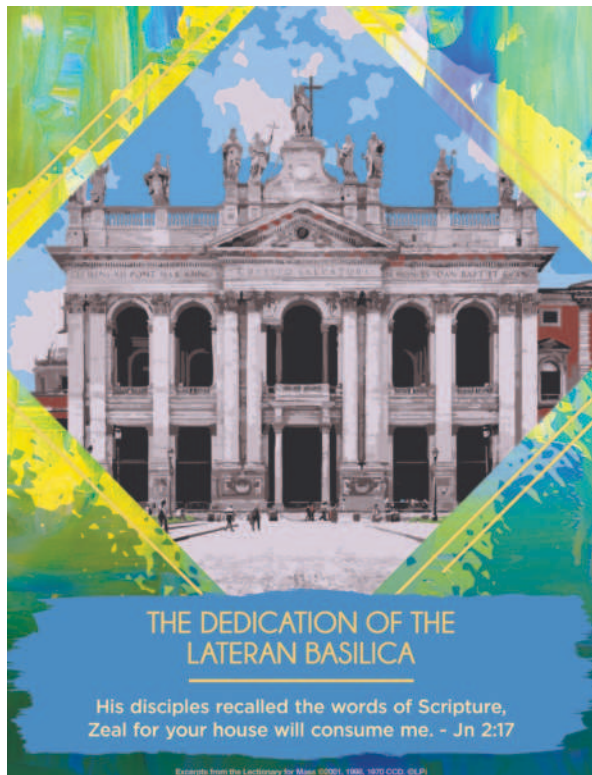

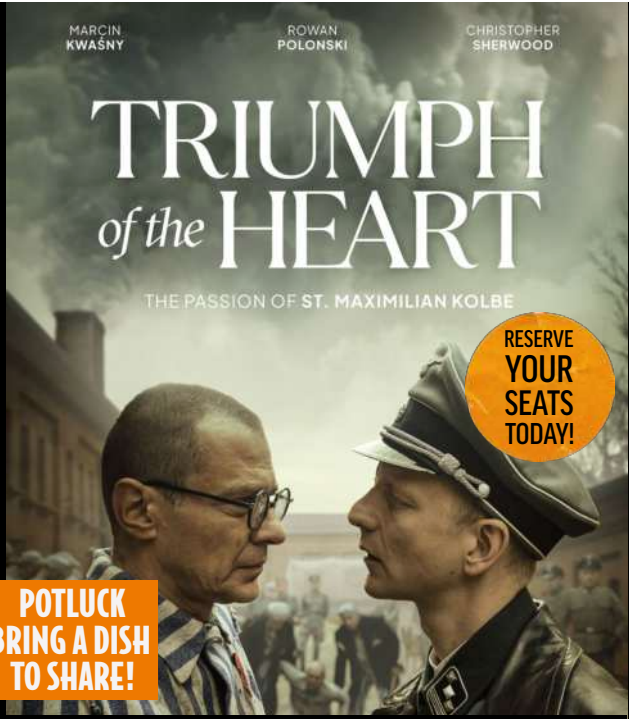

Do you ever wonder what the Knights of Columbus actually do for the Parish and Community? Beyond the obvious coffee and donuts, pancake breakfasts, and fish fries, the Knights are involved with important charity and service activities in the area. These are aligned with four themes:

Faith: The Knights pray the Rosary on the last weekend of every month in the Chapel. The Knights also sponsored the charter bus to the annual Rosary Sunday celebration, provide Sacramental Gifts to Maggie's Place for every baptism, support seminarians through the RSVP program, and many others.

Family: The Knights support the semi annual food drive for community pantries like the Foothills Food Bank. They also support the Feed my Starving Children program and, through donations received at the weekly Coffee and Donuts event, support the Unbound program for poor orphans.

Community: The Knights sponsor the annual essay contest at the St. Gabriel school, Coats for Kids, the annual free throw contest, and fundraisers for needy military families. They also partner with the St. Vincent de Paul on the clothing drives that made St. Gabriel the number one donor of clothing to St. Vincent de Paul in the valley.

Life: The Knights of Columbus support the Baby Bottle drive that raises much needed finds for the Life Choices Women's clinic. On the first Tuesday of each month the Rosary is prayed by the statue of Mary in the courtyard with the intention of protecting all human life from conception to natural death. Gospel Meditation

November 2, 2025

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed
John 6:37-40

November 9, 2025

The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica
John 2:13-22

When I was 22, I entered St. Peter's Basilica for the first time. It floored me. I could hardly take it in, its grandeur, majestic arches, vibrant colors, and the light that danced through its high windows. Somehow, amidst such splendor, I felt an overwhelming sense of belonging, as if I had finally come home.

Jesus reorients how we Catholics see sacred buildings. In today's Gospel he says, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up" (John 2:13-22). His riddle implies, shockingly, that his own body is now the fundamental dwelling place of God and humanity. The temple in Jerusalem has been superseded.

In our churches today — whether they mirror the basilica's grandeur or embrace humble simplicity — we experience architectural symbols of Christ's risen body. It is no accident we call them "churches": they make visible in brick-and-mortar Christ's body which is made up of the living stones we call Christians. Each church building, like St. John Lateran in Rome, or St. Peter's, or any other, is meant to be a vibrant sign of Christ's resurrected body. We should cherish and protect our churches as places where heaven touches earth, where we, as a community, are raised to the fullness of life in Christ.

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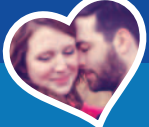
