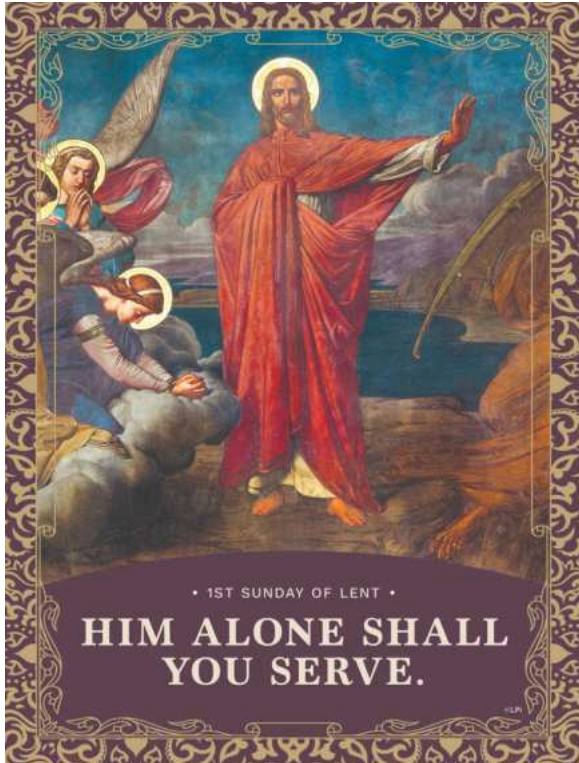

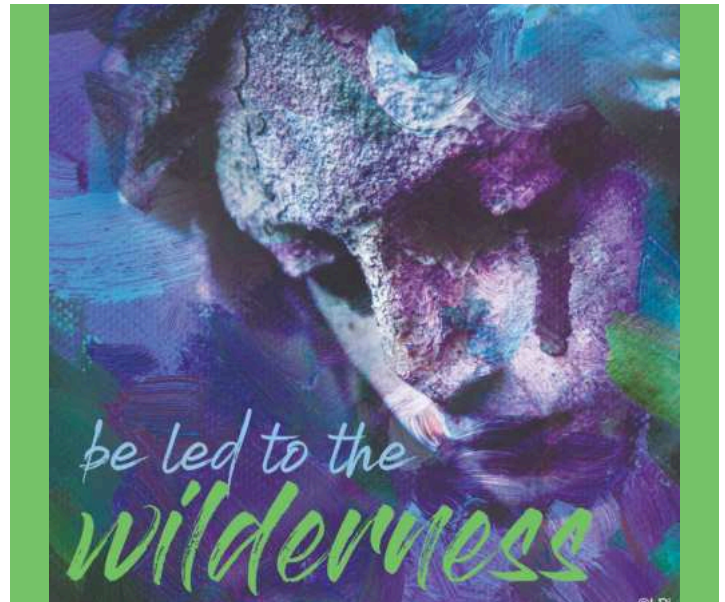

1st Sunday of Lent

Matthew 4:1-11

In my second-to-last year of seminary, I woke up one September morning to devastating news: two beloved classmates had died in a car crash. I was overwhelmed with grief and anger like I had never known. I entered therapy for the first time and had intense conversations with my spiritual director. For months I felt lost in a spiritual wilderness. But something unexpected happened: I encountered Christ there. The fear and sorrow didn't destroy me. In fact, that spiritual desert was a time of intense growth in faith.

Today's Gospel begins: "Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil" (Matthew 4:1). The word "led" denotes a gentle, humble submission to the Spirit. Jesus does not send himself into this desolate place where wild beasts roam and Satan tempts. Who wants to be around roaming, wild beasts? The Church Fathers saw them as symbols of our inner chaos: fears, temptations, wounds. The Spirit leads us there, sometimes against our wishes. But those same Fathers also saw that this deserted place is also where angels ministered to Jesus, amidst his great trial and temptation.

Lenten Challenge: This Lent and throughout life's struggles, the Spirit leads you and me into the wilderness. Name one "desert" into which the Spirit has led you: perhaps grief, fear, silence, change, disappointment. Ask for the grace to go there willingly. The beasts may be real, but they will not harm you. There, the angels are waiting to minister to the Christ living in you, who always goes where the Spirit leads.

Prayer & Fasting This Lent

lessons learned during a 60 day pilgrimage Part 2

Does Fasting really do anything other than make me hungry?

Yes, aside from making you hungry, fasting offers spiritual, mental, and physical benefits by assisting you in turning from carnal desires (physical cravings) to a spiritual hunger, fostering a deeper connection with God:

- It offers spiritual growth, resilience and alignment with the will of the Father, creating discipline in self-mastery and self control.
- It allows you to participate in the remediation of your own sins, as well as those of others. If hunger pains or headaches are experienced, we can align them with the sufferings of Jesus—in His passion and death; which conquered sin. By offering up our sufferances and mortifications during our fasting, we are able to participate in redemptive grace. We are reminded to remain humble and grateful for the gifts we have while becoming keenly aware of our dependence on God.
- It allows for purification as we give our digestive system a break, minimize worldly and fleshly distractions and creates space in our life to focus on our relationship with God.

How do I fast safely?

In addition to the answer on "Where do I begin with Fasting?", if during prayer the Lord places on your heart to seek advice from a physician, please do so. Under most circumstances, the church's guidance on Fasting and Abstinence during Lent are (from the Code of Canon Law – Canons 1249–1253):

- For ages 18–59 (one full meal and two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal; no snacks)
 - For those ages 14 and older abstinence from meat is called for on Ash Wednesday & Fridays of Lent
- Obligatory Days of Abstinence & Fasting are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

How do I know my fasting makes a difference?

I will answer this question in two ways:

1. Do you trust Jesus and his word? The bible is chock full with examples and periods of fasting in both the Old and New Testament. Jesus himself provides instruction on what to do, as well as what not to do when fasting. (Mathew 6:16–18) Other examples are:

- Jesus tells us that some demons can only be driven away by prayer and fasting in Matt 17:21
- An example of seeking Gods will through fasting is given in Acts 13:2–3
- A call of fasting for National Repentance for the Israelites is found in Joel 2–12
- Esther called for a three day fast prior to risking her life in Esther 4:16
- Examples of King David (2 Samuel 12:16) and the prophetess Anna (Luke 2:37) on fasting are provided

2. I also answer from my personal experience on our pilgrimage and since. With fasting, I have gained an insight into the passion of Christ and the incredible humility he showed by obeying our heavenly Father by dying for our sins. I have been comforted by the Lord while fasting and come to know his mercy in my suffering – and experience satiation of mind and body – to include my emotions/instincts, and also my spirit during long term fasting. If you fast properly and in the proper manner, you can't help but feel the Lord's presence.

These fruits that came to us from fasting allowed us to recognize our temptations, unhealed wounds, shame and guilt from our own poor choices; and they was separating us from God. Recognizing these things during our fast—when we were weak, allowed us to experience God's grace in a profound way as is shared in 2 Cor 12:9 "...but he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness.'" I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses, in order that the power of Christ may dwell within me.

There is no greater freedom, soul food or joy than experiencing Christ dwelling in you; which is totally possible and perfectly experienced – if the only food you receive while fasting, is the true presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist!

We can't live on bread alone, but I can testify we can live on the Eucharist alone – at least for 60 days.
