12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 10:26-33

Jean Améry, a Holocaust survivor tortured by the Nazis, later wrote about the abyss of human evil. He described his reaction as an “indignant despair.” Haven’t we all, to some degree, felt that abyss opened beneath us? A sudden loss, a violent headline, a moment of loneliness or panic, when the world feels fragile and meaning seems to collapse?

It is to this fear that Jesus speaks in today’s Gospel: “Do not be afraid of those who can kill the body.” (Matthew 10:28) He does not deny evil or pretend we will never suffer. Instead, He reframes the abyss: do not fear those who can kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Your life is seen, known, and counted by the Father. Even the hairs of your head, even the sparrow’s fall.

This is no superficial comfort. Jesus himself has entered the abyss: suffering, death, even our sense of forsakenness, and he has come through it. That is why his words, “Do not be afraid,” hold such weight. They do not erase the abyss but build a bridge across it.

Faith is not pretending everything is fine. It is staring into the abyss and still choosing trust. And in that trust, we discover we are never alone. Christ stands with us, and the Father’s care surrounds us. That is the only comfort deep enough for our (often fearful) hearts.

A Sacrament Extravaganza



I was raised Catholic but drifted away before completing my Confirmation. My husband, Matt, first felt drawn to the Church as a child and later experienced God's presence while visiting St. Peter's Basilica during his military service. Although he wanted to become Catholic, he did not know how.

In 2012, I knew my life needed to change. I returned to prayer, joined the United States Air Force, and met Matt while stationed at Travis Air Force Base in 2016. We later moved to Arizona, were civilly married, and welcomed our son, Dean.

My father's death in 2023 became a turning point. He had always helped keep me connected to the Church and had given me many Catholic books. After he passed, I began praying and studying more deeply. Matt and I both felt that something was still missing from our lives.

In 2025, we returned to Mass and found St. Gabriel. A bulletin announcement for adults needing Confirmation led us to meet with Deacon Matthew Irish and begin OCIA and marriage preparation. We finally found the answers and faith community we had been seeking.

Our journey included unexpected delays, which taught us to surrender control and trust in God's plan. With the support of our parish community, we persevered.


On May 30, 2026, our civil wedding anniversary, we received six sacraments during what Fr. Chad called a "Sacrament Extravaganza." Matt was baptized, we were both confirmed, we were married in the Catholic Church, and Matt received the Eucharist for the first time.

That day, we experienced an overwhelming sense of God's love and the presence of the Holy Spirit. Our faith has strengthened our marriage, brought our lives into right order, and marked the beginning of a new journey with God.

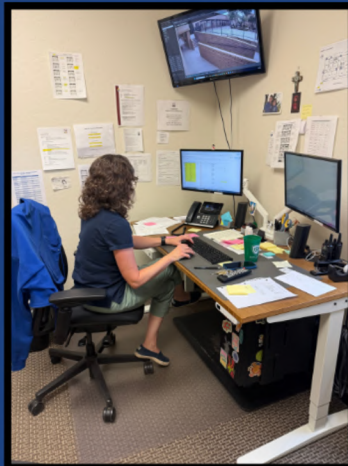

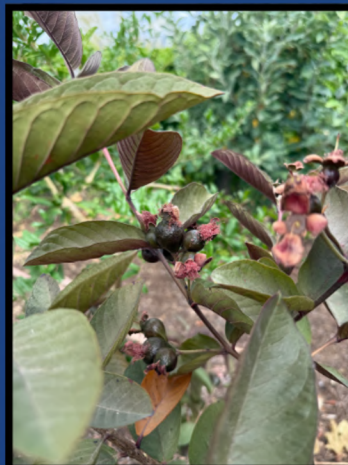
